If an employee does not have a photo ID available, they can request an ID at SAIN: Calle 2 #200, Local 7 y 8 entre Avenida y Callejon Felix Contreras. (Please note, all patients will be seen by a primary care physician before being referred to any specialist.)

**Step 3:** Copay's will be based on the employees' medical plan. Applicable co-pays will be payable to the provider at the time services are rendered.
