# **About the Summary Annual Report**

This is a summary of the annual report of the United Agricultural Benefit Trust ("UABT" or the "Plan"), Employer Identification Number 33.0013118 (Plan No. 501), an association sponsored health and welfare benefit plan providing medical, dental, vision, prescription and group term life and accidental death and dismemberment insurance benefits for the prior year ending December 31, 2024. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

UABT is sponsored by United Agribusiness League ("UnitedAg"), which administers the Plan at the direction of the Board of Trustees on behalf of the participating employers and has committed itself to pay self-funded medical, dental, vision and prescription claims incurred under the terms of the Plan.

# **Insurance Information**

UABT has a stop loss insurance contract with Great Midwest Insurance Company that provides excess loss coverage on both specific and aggregate levels for claims incurred under the terms of UABT. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2024 for Great Midwest Insurance Company stop loss insurance were \$2,394,950.

UABT contracts with Unum to pay all group term life, accidental death and dismemberment claims. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2024, to UNUM for group life insurance benefits were \$69,861.

### **Basic Financial Statement**

The value of plan assets, after subtracting liabilities of the plan, was \$91,273,413 as of December 31, 2024, compared to \$72,361,487 as of January 1, 2024. During the plan year the plan experienced an increase in its net assets of \$18,911,926. This increase includes unrealized appreciation and depreciation in the value of plan assets; that is, the difference between the value of the plan's assets at the end of the year and the value of the assets at the beginning of the year or the cost of assets acquired during the year. During the plan year, the plan had total income of \$254,533,333 including employer contributions of \$249,003,902, employee contributions of \$1,575,273, realized gains of \$5,651 from the sale of assets, and earnings from investments of \$3,948,507.

Plan expenses were \$237,143,268. These expenses included \$30,489,411 in administrative expenses, \$195,072,104 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries, and \$11,581,753 in other expenses.

- all stages of reconstruction of the breast on which the mastectomy was performed;
- surgery and reconstruction of the other breast to produce a symmetrical appearance;
- prostheses, and
- treatment of physical complications of the mastectomy, including lymphedema.
