



## Pre-Employment Health Screening Services

Service	Description
<p><b>Covid-19 test-</b> Corona virus is a type of disease that can spread from person to person. Spreads mainly through respiratory droplets, add such as, coughing, sneezing, or talking.</p>	<p>Nasal swab to determine if you are negative or positive for corona virus. Results takes within 48-72 hours of test.</p>
<p><b>Tuberculosis</b> - Tuberculosis is a serious disease which mainly affects the lungs. It can spread from one person to another such as tiny droplets released into air (sneezing, and coughing)</p>	<p>Test done on the forearm to see if you have been exposed to tuberculosis, requires a reading within the forearm 48-72 hours.</p>
<p><b>Hair Follicle testing</b> - Screens for illicit drug use and the misuse of prescription medication.</p>	<p>A small amount of hair is removed from your head, the sample is then analyzed for signs of drug use during the 90 days preceding the test.</p>
<p><b>Alcohol Screen (Saliva)</b> - Screening test used to detect ethyl alcohol in human saliva. Requires a small amount of salvia to detect relative blood alcohol greater or equal to 0.02% BAC (blood alcohol content)</p>	<p>Rapid Saliva test to check if there are any alcohol in the system.</p>
<p><b>COC Urine (Collection only)</b> - Chain of custody urine collection is a urine sample collected to determine if you have drugs or alcohol in your system.</p>	<p>Urine test to determine if there are drugs in your system. Negative results take 24 hours non-negative takes 24 to 72 hours.</p>
<p><b>COC Breathalyzer-</b> A device used for estimating blood alcohol content from a breath sample</p>	<p>A machine you breathe into to check your alcohol blood level.</p>
<p><b>Hep B vaccine-</b> Recombinant is used to prevent infection by the hepatitis B virus. The vaccine works by causing your body to produce its own antibodies against the disease.</p>	<p>A serious liver infection caused by Hep B virus; Vaccine is given as a two or three dose series, depending on the age you first received the vaccine.</p>
<p><b>Hep B Titer-</b> Titer testing measures the antibodies level, indicate that a person is immune to a particular virus or infection.</p>	<p>To determine if they need the Hep B vaccines, they will need to draw blood to measure the level of antibodies.</p>
<p><b>Tetanus-</b> Bacterial infection that causes painful muscle spasms that affects the nerves. Once vaccine is injected the toxoid elicits and immune response against the toxin.</p>	<p>The tetanus shot will prevent you from getting an infection caused by a deep cut, burns, bites.</p>

<p><b>Rapid Drug 5 Panel-</b> Rapid tests point is to collect testing, provides on-site screening for drugs of the abuse, urine specimen validity and saliva alcohol.</p>	<p>Collection of urine is needed to do a drug test; test will be read within 5 mins.</p>
<p><b>Mask fit test-</b> Conducted to ensure the respirator is properly fitted to individual's face type to provide the safest protection. Test involves the taste sensitivity of the person being tested.</p>	<p>Mask fit testing is done by performing a fit test on you while you wear the same make mode, size of respirator that you will be using on the job.</p>
<p><b>CBC-</b> Group of tests that evaluate the cells that circulate in blood, including red blood cells, white blood cells, and platelets. CBC can evaluate your overall health and detect a variety of diseases and conditions.</p>	<p>Blood draw to review the cells in your body to see if you have any blood disorders, it checks for infections, anemia and leukemia.</p>
<p><b>Cholinesterase-</b> Blood test that looks at levels of 2 substances that help the nervous system work properly also called <b>Acetylcholinesterase</b>, our nerves need these substances to send signals.</p>	<p>Blood drawn to detect acute poisoning or to monitor those with occupational exposure such as to chemicals, farm workers, or those who work with industrial chemicals.</p>
<p><b>Urinalysis-</b> A urinalysis is used to detect and manage a wide range of disorders, such as urinary tract infections, kidney disease and diabetes.</p>	<p>Urine test to detect if you have any sort of disorder such as UTI, Kidney disease and diabetes and more.</p>
<p><b>Employment Physical-</b> Employment physical is an exam to assure employees are physically and mentally able to take on the responsibilities of a job.</p>	<p>Physical done to determine if you are fit for the job.</p>
<p><b>DMV Medical Exam-</b> Documents prepared by a Physician, Physician's Assistant, Nurse Practitioner, or Chiropractor to document driver meets the national medical standards necessary to operate a commercial vehicle.</p>	<p>Physical/documents required and filled out by practitioner to make sure you are eligible to drive commercial vehicle.</p>
<p><b>X-Ray 2 views-</b> Changing the relative orientation of the body and the direction of the x-ray beam. The most common views are posteroanterior, anteroposterior, and lateral.</p>	<p>2 view x-ray includes the front and back view to vague.</p>
<p><b>X-Ray Lumber Spine-</b> Abnormal curves of the spine. Abnormal wear on the cartilage and bones of the lower spine, such as bone spurs and narrowing of the joints between the vertebrae.</p>	<p>X-ray of small bones in the lower part of the spine.</p>
