OUR HISTORY

In 1980, the members of UnitedAg intuitively knew they needed a unique health plan to meet the needs of the agricultural workforce within the state. They sought a health plan that would operate on a non-profit basis, offer a diversity of plan designs, and offer customer service designed to accommodate the needs of the ag employees. These employers created United Agricultural Employee Welfare and Benefit Trust (UABT), an ERISA Multiple Employer Welfare Arrangement, that grew from 6 small farms to more than 1,000 member companies. Providing access to healthcare to over 55,000 members, UnitedAg and the Trust has grown to over \$220 million in annual contributions.
